Therapy

Early Intervention Programs enhance the abilities of children who are developmentally at risk. Services are offered in the child's home, at the Centre or in a preschool or daycare environment.

- ◇ **Speech & Language Therapy** when there are concerns about a child's ability to understand and use language to communicate effectively.
- ◇ **Occupational Therapy** when there are concerns about a child's motor, play, or self-help skills. The focus is on teaching skills and adapting the environment to promote independence.
- ◇ **Physiotherapy** when there are gross motor, orthopedic or neurological concerns.
- ◇ **Infant Development Program** when there are concerns about delays in any area of development for children newborn to 3 years of age.
- ◇ **Supported Child Development Program** when a child requires extra support to participate successfully in a licensed preschool or daycare program.

Preschool

A language-enriched program for children aged 30 months to 5 years. Preschool is offered from September to June.

Funded by parent fees

We accept referrals from parents. Referrals are also accepted from community professionals and other family members with parent's consent.

Programs are offered for children from birth to school-entry.
